ABSENCE OF THE MANAGER POLICY

In the absence of the Manager, the deputy Manager would ensure that high standards of care continue to be provided to the children.

This includes ensuring that all policies and procedures are upheld including but not limited to:

- Staff effectively deployed throughout BASK
- Ensure food hygiene standards are being maintained
- Ensure security of the children are upheld
- Liaising with parents/carers as appropriate
- Accurately maintain BASK's registers and documentation concerning health and safety and child protection
- Uphold BASK's confidentiality policy
- Ensure planning for the individual needs of each child is maintained to a high standard

Any other task that could be reasonably expected of a manager including but not limited to:

- Understand and fully implement the policies and procedures
- Ensure staff are aware of the policies and values.
- Share good childcare practice with colleagues, display exemplary behaviour and act as a role model.
- Provide high quality care and activities for children which recognise both individual and group requirements in a secure, safe and stimulating environment
- Organise activities, both inside and outside, which encourages creativity, development, co-ordination, independence and self-expression through play
- Be aware of Safeguarding issues and follow BASK's Safeguarding procedures
- Ensure close monitoring of children about whom there are concerns
- Fully comply with the outside policy to ensure the safety of children outside BASK's premises.
- Co-operate in the implementation of the health and safety policy and ensure that the environment meets health and safety standards
