BASK Homework Policy

BASK HOMEWORK POLICY

Whilst **BASK** is primarily a play environment, this aspect of our service is client led. Many parents request that written homework be completed during after school sessions, as children are often very tired when they get home after 6pm. Therefore, children who attend **BASK** will be given time and space to complete any written homework tasks when necessary.

Homework will be supervised by **BASK** staff, however staff will not 'sign off' any written homework, or do reading homework with the children – this will be done at home.

- When children arrive at **BASK** they will register and have a snack – this should take no more than half an hour.
- After snack, the children will settle down to any written homework tasks – they will be allowed as much time as necessary to complete these tasks.
- Staff will supervise the homework sessions, and ensure that the children do complete their tasks as far as possible (for example if the use of a computer etc is needed then this will not be possible).
- If numbers and staffing allow, the children may work in the following groups – P/J1 and P/J2 together, P/J3 and P/J4 together and P/J5 upwards together (or as individuals if they prefer to do so.)
- Staff will ask children to check that completed homework is returned to bags.
- Any other planned activities should take place after homework is completed.
